

Lioncare Project : Leprosy Patients Annual Visit

Lioncare is one of Lionheart Society's main projects. The aim of this undertaking is to provide financial assistance to poor patients to meet medical expenses and kidney patients undergoing dialysis as well as scholarship grants to patients infected with HIV from birth.

Under this project, for the past 3 years, we have also been involved in providing help and assistance to elderly patients suffering from last stage leprosy at Raj Pracha Samasai Institute located at Samut Prakan province. This aid does not only come in forms of monetary and material contributions but our visits include giving moral encouragement and emotional support as most of these patients have already been abandoned by their own families, enduring a life of misery and isolation. In addition to this, our donations also cover expenses for social activities such as group excursions which take place 3-4 times a year.

Through our visits, we hope to be able to reach out to these victims and let them know that there are still others who care for them, understand their needs and are willing to help them in any way possible.
